NARRATIVE REPORT ON EARTHQUAKE DRILL SY 2014-2015

The Pantingan Elementary School supports the National School-Based Earthquake Drill which aims to generate the highest level of awareness among the pupils and teachers in the school during emergencies or disasters.

Mr. Angelito Licup, HT-III, together with the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Group, observed the safe zone in the school which will serve as evacuation areas during the earthquake.

Mrs. Gloria V. Cruz, Science Coordinator, together with the other teachers, conducted lectures on earthquake drills last June 27. Teachers explained the details on what to do during sudden earthquakes. Good practices and safe zones were taught during the discussion. Other teachers and pupils also gave suggestions on what to do during an earthquake.

After the discussions, intensive practices/drills followed. During the drill, the children will go to the safe zone as soon as they heard the three consecutive ringing of the school bell. They will go to the safe zone while performing the "duck, cover and hold".



The Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Group chose this school site as the safe zone / evacuation area during an earthquake.







Pupils hid themselves under the tables and chairs while waiting for the shaking to stop before immediately leaving to the safe area.





The pupils showed on what to do as soon as the earthquakes stop. They immediately evacuate the school building using the pre-determined route going to the evacuation/safe areas.





The pupils grouped together as soon as they arrived at the designated evacuation/safe areas while performing the "duck, cover and hold."
