attended by the Municipal Council for the Protection of Children (MCPC), headed by the Chairman Hon. Mayor Alice D. Pizarro, DSWD Jenny Lee Casin and SPO1 Gilda Candido, in-charge of PNP Women and Children’s Desk. They shared topics on the responsibilities of parents/ guardians and law that might be used against violators of the said rights. Some situations on child abuse were cited by SPO1 Candido to awaken parents that these things are really happening in the community.

Mrs. Torres discussed DepEd order no. 40. This assures that abuse in the school is not tolerated. Mrs. Clarissa P. Benjamin, Teacher III explained the pupils' handbook. The members too of the CPC were introduced to the parents and guardian. There are officials too from the Barangay Council. During the discussion participants were very attentive and interested. There were about 300 attendees.
